

St. Louis Catholic Church Youth Ministry is proud to sponsor two Cole Harrison Smith Memorial Scholarships. A \$3,000 scholarship and a \$1,000 scholarship are awarded annually to two graduating seniors who have been active in parish youth ministry at St. Louis Church. The scholarships are given in loving memory of a baby who was loved dearly and is deeply missed. His father, Alan Smith, has devoted many years of service to St. Louis youth ministry and, together with Cole's mother and extended family, wishes to support two annual scholarships in Cole's honor.

In addition, each year's recipients will have their names engraved on the commemorative plaque that is displayed at St. Louis Catholic Church in the St. John Paul II Youth Ministry Center.

Requirements

The scholarships are awarded annually to two seniors who most exemplify the values of our faith: approaching others with dignity and respect; believing in the self-worth of all people; advocating the Catholic faith; and leading by example, thus being a role model for peers.

The most important factor in granting these scholarships is not academic excellence, but the example of living out his/her Christian values and beliefs, providing an example for his/her fellow students and other youth involved in the youth ministry program.

Any senior in high school pursuing post-secondary education who is active in St. Louis Catholic Church Youth Ministry is eligible to apply for the scholarships.

Application Process

An application is included in this packet. The deadline for return of applications to the St. Louis Catholic Church Youth Ministry office is **Monday**, **March 25**. The recipients will be announced, and the awards will be given at our Senior Recognition event on April 28.

Selection Committee

All applications returned by Monday, March 25 will be reviewed, and the recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a committee composed of the following*: St. Louis Church Pastor, Alan Smith, Catherine Smith, Director of Youth Ministry, Associate Director of Youth Ministry, Men's Club President, and other representatives to be appointed by the Director of Youth Ministry.

*If a relative of a member of the selection committee should apply, that committee member will be asked to step aside during the selection process.

Dear Potential Recommender,

Thank you for considering taking time to support a young person in their pursuit of a Cole Harrison Memorial Scholarship from the St. Louis Catholic Church Youth Ministry. The scholarships are awarded annually to two seniors who most exemplify the values of our faith: approaching others with dignity and respect; believing in the self-worth of all people; advocating the Catholic faith; and leading by example, thus being a role model for peers.

The most important factor in granting these scholarships is not academic excellence, but the example of living out his/her Christian values and beliefs, providing an example for his/her fellow students and other youth involved in the youth ministry program.

Any senior in high school, pursuing post-secondary education, who is active in St. Louis Catholic Church Youth Ministry is eligible to apply for the scholarship.

The following are some ideas of what you may want to include in your letter, if you are interested:

- Briefly describe the length of time you have known the candidate and the circumstances under which you have known him/her.
- Briefly describe his/her outstanding contributions to church life.
- Briefly describe the outstanding character and personality of the candidate.
- Briefly describe the youth's ability to instill in others a sense of self-worth.
- Briefly describe ways in which this youth promotes the Catholic faith.
- Briefly describe how this youth lives out Christian values in his/her parish and/or community.

The scholarship application is due by Monday, March 25, so please return your letter to the applicant with time to allow them to meet the deadline.
